
Assembly Instructions



(*Rack shown with L-Rod substituting included straight rod on snare arm)

<u>Parts List</u> Please review your parts list to ensure you have all of the necessary components

- **A.** 36" Curved bar w/4 multi clamps, 2 L rods, and 2 brace clamps
- **B.** 34" Straight bar (leg upright) w/2 T clamps, 2 leg brace, & brace clamp
- C. 34" Straight bar (leg upright) w/3 T clamps, 1 leg brace, and 2 brace clamps
- **D.** (**X2**) 22" Rack foot assembly (1 T clamp, 2 rubber feet, & 1 leg brace)
- **E.** 22" Straight extension bar w/2 multi purpose clamps (L rod clamps), 1 L rod, 1 leg brace
- F. (X2) 14" Straight extension w/1 L rod clamp & 1 L rod



Step 1- "Building rack legs & feet"

- Locate the two component sets labeled "D"
- Place foot assemblies on floor and rotate rubber feet until they are flush with the floor



• Place 34" uprights ("C") into T clamps on foot assemblies



• Place the leg braces into the brace clamps as shown



You've now completed your two upright assemblies.

Step 2- "Installing horizontal front bar and stabilizing"

• Locate 36" curved bar "A"



• Loosen T clamps at the top of completed upright assemblies. Insert the ends of curved bar into T clamps, and brace uprights as shown.



Step 3- "Installing Extensions & finalizing Rack"

- Locate components "E" and "F"
- Loosen remaining T clamps on uprights

• Insert rack extensions into their corresponding T – clamps, as shown



Now that setup is complete, adjust the rack to your liking and check over all hex and drum key bolts to make sure they are all secure.
